BUSINESS CONTINUITY POLICY

As specified in the Company Manual Management, our mission is to seek Customers' satisfaction by tackling each challenge with safe, reliable and innovative solutions, from the proposal phase and through the project execution phase and to ensure the health and safety of our employees and subcontractors.

Ensuring business continuity is a strategic priority of our company:

- > To reduce risks that could disrupt our ability to deliver to our customers
- > To promote resilience

Antrak Logistics' policy is to develop, implement and maintain a Business Continuity Management System (BCMS) that ensures that business critical functions are available and to maintain acceptable levels of service and consistency.

The main objective is to define the strategic and tactical capability of Antrak Logistics to plan for and respond to major business interruptions to enable our company to continue its core business activities at an acceptable level, to limit the Company's vulnerability (secure the short and mid-term sustainability of the company) and to minimize the loss of Customer confidence.

To achieve this aim, Antrak Logistics adopts a system of Business Continuity Management.

Business Continuity Management is seen as the process by which Antrak Logistics maintains and recovers its business and operational effectiveness against 'risks and threats' which if realized may materialize as serious business continuity incident and could ultimately escalate into a full scale Crisis or Situation.

BCP is an additional package in relation to the Crisis management procedure.

The plan identifies vulnerabilities and recommends necessary measures to prevent extended service outages. It is a plan that encompasses all of Antrak Logistics' systems and operations facilities.
